that the Lord chose such a birth.


Not by human flesh and blood,

For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours now and forever. Amen.



C: For us and for our salvation, he came down from heaven,


was incarnate of the Holy Spirit

Exhortation to those receiving The Lord's Supper
